



Village of Chicago Ridge
Major Avenue Water Main Replacement
Public Notice of Construction
May 31, 2022



Dear Resident or Property Owner,

This summer the Village of Chicago Ridge is scheduled to begin work outside of your residence. The limits of construction are anticipated to be:

1. Major Avenue (111th Street to 109th Street)

The existing water main will be replaced with new ductile iron water main pipe. Construction activities for the installation of the new water main, water services, and storm sewer are typically expected from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with possible Saturday work. Construction is anticipated to start in mid-June and continue through early September 2022.

This construction work requires that we restrict the streets to be No Parking on both sides **while the water main work is ongoing on your block**. Temporary “No Parking” signs will be posted where needed and we ask for your cooperation to park elsewhere. **The permanent restoration of your street will begin after the water main, water service, and sewer work is complete (under a separate contract)**. Updates and additional notices will be provided as the project progresses.

Residents will be allowed to park their vehicles on the street overnight but must be moved by 7:00 a.m.

The streets will generally be open to traffic during construction. During working hours, access will be limited to local traffic only. If you need your vehicle for frequent trips during the day, we recommend that you move your vehicle prior to 7:00 a.m. and park on an adjacent street with available on-street parking. Access will be restored at the end of each work day. You will be able to access your driveway, except when the new curb and gutter or driveway aprons are placed. Further information will be provided in advance if your driveway access will be affected.

Please do not remove the construction stakes or utility located flags placed along the roadway. They serve an important purpose during the water main construction. If these are removed, the construction progress could be delayed as they will need to be replaced.

Please understand that construction could be delayed during periods of inclement weather.

Refuse, Recycling, and Mail service should not be impacted during construction.

The General Contractor performing the work will be Suburban General Construction (LaGrange Park, IL).
